

## <u>Sermon Discussion Guide – Wisdom to Ask the Right Questions</u>

- 1. What is your response to the current coronavirus situation? How can you spread joy, hope and faith?
- 2. Through what kind of situations did God deliver Paul (see 2 Corinthians 11:24-27)? In your own life, how has God delivered you?
- 3. In 2 Corinthians 1:3-11 Paul writes of comfort and affliction. How do these verses encourage you today? What action can you take in light of them?
- 4. Philippians 4:19 reads, "And my God will supply all your needs according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus." What is significant about the context of this verse (see verses 10-20)?
- 5. Revelation 12:10 tells us that there is an accuser (Satan) who accuses us before God. Contrast this with Hebrews 7:25, which tells us we have an intercessor (Jesus Christ) who is praying for us and will save us completely. Why is this so important?
- 6. We have a tendency to condemn ourselves, but what does Jesus say about his children? What does He expect of us (see John 8)?
- 7. Even in the difficult times of life and no matter the circumstances, how can we be assured that God loves us unconditionally and will never forsake us?
- 8. Have you ever felt like God forgot about you or did not hear your prayers? Share how God brought you through that season. If you feel like that today, what should you do?
